Important Note – Read and follow all of these instructions carefully. Applications that do not comply with these instructions may be disqualified.

PURPOSE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The NICE (North Idaho Code Enforcers) Scholarship was established to promote education within the construction industry. The purpose of NICE is to advance, educate and improve efforts of communication among code professionals and individuals in our area; promoting cooperation, coordination and good working relationships.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Scholarships will be available to:

- Members of, or children of members of, NICE.
- Members of ICC (International Code Council) Chapters within Idaho
- Members of IDABO (Idaho Association of Building Officials)
- Students enrolled in credit or non credit programs

Awards may be used at the education facility of their choice. An applicant is only eligible for one award per year. The maximum number of years that funds may be granted to a single applicant is four years. In the event that a member of the scholarship committee is related to an applicant for the scholarship, that committee member shall be excused from deliberations. Another member of NICE will be selected to take that individual's place on the scholarship committee.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants are evaluated on the following criteria:

- Be pursuing educational opportunities beyond the high school level at a recognized and/or accredited institution.

- Provide evidence of satisfactory scholastic achievement including grades, test scores and teacher recommendations *if* required by the selection committee.
- Complete the scholarship Application, and provide a one page narrative on why the applicant believes he/she should be awarded the scholarship.
- **Preferential** consideration will be given to the applicants enrolled in classes in a construction related curriculum.
- All portions of the application must be completed and submitted. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all portions of the application are received by the deadline. *Applications received after the deadline may not be considered.*

SELECTION PROCESS

- The eligibility of the applicants will be verified.
- The applications will be reviewed to determine if all required information has been furnished.
- The committee will review all eligible applications using the Scholarship Selection Criteria.
- The recipient of the scholarship award will be selected by the NICE Scholarship Committee and notified in writing by the committee.

AWARD INFORMATION

- Scholarships up to \$100 will be awarded.

APPLICATION SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **Application** – Use the official application form or a photocopy of the form. Answer **all** questions.
2. One-page narrative from the applicant explaining why he/she should be awarded the scholarship.

All selection decisions are final and are not subject to appeal. Applications and support papers become the sole property of the NICE Scholarship Committee and will not be returned.

RECEIPT DEADLINE

All materials must be **received** as one submittal. Applications received in full or part after the deadline may not be considered.
